



Thistle – Flower of Scotland

Instructions:

Cloth: 14 count white Aida Cloth
Grid Size: 56W x 56 H
Design Area: 3.86" x 4.00"
Floss: DMC – Use 2 strands for all full stitches and 1 strand for all back-stitches.

Back-stitches:

799 Delft Blue – dashed lines around the ribbon.
3790 Beige Gray – Squiggle lines at the base of the flower blooms. These are to be stitched as straight lines.
3803 Mauve – These are dashed-lines, found only on the small bloom. These are to be stitched as straight lines.
3835 Grape – These are dotted-lines found around the edge of the large bloom. These are to be stitched as straight lines.
3815 Celadon Green – These are shown as ‘tracks’. These are found among the leaves. These are to be stitched as straight lines.
3837 Lavender – These are straight lines found on both of the blooms.

Photocopy the pattern and enlarge at least 200% for better legibility. Begin at the center and work darker colors first. Once all full cross-stitches have been completed, then the backstitched can be added on top of the full x-stitches. Block to frame, or stuff to create door pillow. Add tassels or fringe as desired.
